

Take-it-Easy Oven™

Portable Food Warmer



Operating Procedure

- Includes 12V power supply cord that plugs into car cigarette lighter
- An LED on the power cord indicates that warmer is powered up and ready for use
- Pre-heat food warmer for 15 minutes
- Insert desired contents into warmer

Safety Precautions

- CAUTION HOT – AVOID PROLONGED CONTACT WITH INSIDE SURFACES.
- UNPLUG FOOD WARMER WHEN NOT IN USE. (Battery drain will depend on age and condition of battery. Typically, the food warmer can safely be run for 2 hours with vehicle ignition off).
- DO NOT IMMERSE IN ANY LIQUID.
- ALLOW TO COOL BEFORE CLEANING.
- DO NOT DISASSEMBLE OR ATTEMPT TO SERVICE FOOD WARMER IN ANY WAY.
- DO NOT UNPLUG BY PULLING ON THE POWER CORD. GENTLY PULL THE PLUG FROM RECEPTACLE.
- FOOD WARMER IS DESIGNED TO PLUG INTO 12V SIZE A OUTLET. ENSURE POWER OUTLET IS COMPATIBLE.
- DO NOT HARD WIRE FOOD WARMER DIRECTLY TO POWER SOURCE.
- IF YOU ARE EXPERIENCING PROBLEMS DISCONNECT IMMEDIATELY AND CONTACT CUSTOMER SERVICE AT THE NUMBER BELOW.
